ABOUT DISCOVERY

Discovery School is a private, international non-profit school with a unique learning environment. Founded in 1993, it is located in a purpose-built facility on the outskirts of Tegucigalpa, Honduras, in Central America. With students from over 15 different countries, our diversity is one of our greatest strengths.







Our campus is divided into five sections: Secondary, Elementary, Early Childhood, Special Classes (French, Art, Science Lab, and Music), and **Administration.** In addition, there is a cafeteria, a soccer field, an open-air gym, a basketball court, two recreation areas for the younger students, and a green common area.

Our school was founded on the belief that small classroom sizes, hands-on learning experiences, and inquiry approach are pivotal for meaningful teaching and learning. These are enduring principles that continues to guide us today.


GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Discovery School grants a High School diploma with U.S. certification to students who have successfully completed at least 24 credits (grades 9th-12th). It also offers students the option of earning the national degree of Bachillerato Internacional en Ciencias y Humanidades granted by the Honduran Ministry of Education by completing additional credits. The Advanced Placement International Diploma (APID) is also available for those students who meet the requirements. One credit is earned for each full-year course. One-half credit is earned for a semester course.

GRADING SYSTEM, GPA, AND RANKING

Discovery School uses a 100-point scale grading system for all academic subjects with a **passing grade of 70** as mandated by the Honduran Ministry of Education. Due to our small classes, we do not provide the specific rank of our students. The 2023 graduating class was composed of 9 students. AP classes with a score above 80% receive a 10% bonus. Discovery School provides the GPA on a quarterly basis in report cards but is not published in the transcript.


